GUIDE FOR APPLICANTS

Position: **Safety Promotion Officer - Sports**

Purpose: This guide provides information about the process for the recruitment and selection of the Safety Promotion Officer – Sports within the Accident Compensation Corporation.

MAKING AN APPLICATION

GENERAL:

Your application for this position should include:

1. A short cover letter expressing interest in the position and an indication of when the applicant can start in the position if appointed;
2. A most recent curriculum vitae in three pages;
3. Complete referee details and authorization form;
4. Certified copies of all certificates of academic achievements, qualifications, trainings, professional affiliation and other documents provided in support of your application. (Certified copies are those that are seen and verified by an Officer of the Court as true copies of the originals);

CURRICULUM VITAE: Your CV should include:

1. Details of your work history, including the following information for every position held:
 - position title, employer and the dates you held the position
 - a list of achievements
 - a brief summary of key accountabilities

Certified copies of academic achievements, qualifications, trainings, professional affiliation and other documents provided in support of your application.

2. Contact details

REFEREE DETAILS:

Provide three (3) written references with two (2) referees dated within 12 months.

AUTHORIZATION FORM:

In signing the attached Authorization Form you are allowing the Board of the Accident Compensation Corporation or a designated representative to undertake the following checks:

- Approach in confidence the referees you have named and other people who have personal knowledge of you, to gather information related to your suitability for this appointment. You will be contacted if it is considered helpful to approach any referees not named in the application.
- Security checks from the Ministry of Police and general security clearance with other agencies will also be undertaken.

OBJECTIVES

The objective of the Safety Promotion and Prevention Division is to take a leading role in the reduction of social, economic and physical impact of accidents on the worker and the community through the promotion of safety and in rehabilitating the victims.

DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES

The appointee will be largely responsible for:

1. Conducting field investigation and research of accidents or personal injuries from sports and related activities and updating the accident database through on-going data entry, data cleansing and data analysis for producing quality output reports;
2. Working harmoniously with other Safety Promotion Officers toward interpreting and translating accident data for formulating, planning, organizing and implementing of safety trainings and promoting of accident prevention programs in sports and related activities;
3. Providing timely and high-quality reports and advices for use by management and other stakeholders on issues relating to safety, and accident prevention programs for sports and related activities;
4. Maintaining effective liaison with government and NGO's and other stakeholders towards establishing a close and effective working relationship and partnership for the safety in sports and related activities; and
5. Any other relevant duties as directed by the immediate supervisor of the Manager Safety Promotion and Rehabilitation or any one of the Management from time to time.

Minimum Requirements:

1. Diploma or degree in Occupational Safety and Health Management, Sports Management or related fields with at least 3 years relevant work experience;
2. Computer literate with excellent analytical and report writing skills;
3. Honest, committed and reliable and is willing to be part of the team;
4. Fluent in English and Samoan both written and oral;
5. Ability and flexibility to work long hours when needed with minimum supervision; and
6. Good public relation skills.

Key Competencies:

1. Sound problem solving capabilities and flexibility of approach.
2. Ability to maintain high workloads, and meet deadlines within specified time frames.
3. Ability to demonstrate strong teamwork and collaboration skills with high personal motivation.
4. Good attention to details.
5. Good presentation and interpersonal skills.
6. Good organizational and planning skills.
